- 5. The Ministry after exploring all the options with the facts available to it believes there is no option to concessioning the Ajaokuta Steel Plant. It is in the light of the above that the Ministry is committed to pursuing the concessioning process through the most open and transparent way to avoid the mistakes of the past.
- 6. Finally, the Honourable Ministers wish to work with the Leadership of the National Assembly in an honest collaborative way to ensure the success of the process. The Honourable Ministers are open to any suggestions or ideas that will help to ensure that all matters relating to Ajaokuta Steel Co. Ltd. are resolved in the interest of our country.
- 7. While we look forward to working with the National Assembly on this matter, please accept the assurances of my high regards.
