The above subject matter and your letter dated 20th August 2018 with respect to same refer.

We are Solicitors to the former Minister of Culture and Tourism, the former Minister of Aviation, and a renowned Barrister and Solicitor of the Supreme Court of Nigeria, **Chief Femi Fani-Kayode**, who is hereinafter referred to as "**Our Client**" and it is on his definite instruction that we make the following representation.

Your office, for reasons best known to them, did not mention the name (s) and person(s) complaining against our Client and on what particular subject matter his presence is required. **(Kindly find attached to this letter, a copy of the said invitation letter.)**

Therefore, in view of the short notice apparent in your letter under reference, our Client is constrained to politely request for a rescheduling of the interview date and also that he be furnished with essential particulars of the purpose of his visit to your office so as to adequately prepare for the said 'interview'.
