mid the eco-nomic downtum triggered by the coronavirus pan-demic which has enforced a modification of business and commercial activities, over 40 percent of stricted access to foreign ex-change (FOREX) for business activities

COVID-19: Nigerian schools to introduce shift, day interval academic system

...as schools lack required infrastructure

Public primary and sec-ondary schools across the 774 local government areas in Nigeris may in-troduce a shift education poli-cy due to their inability to meet Covid-19 standard of safety recommended for reopening. The schools are expected

recommended for reopening.

The schools are expected to commence academic programme on September 21, 2020 but investigations carlied out by BusinessDay, shows that many of the schools are without required Infrastructure and other essential facilities to accommodate the large numbers of students per class.

At the moment, a good number of primary and post-primary schools in the country accommodate between 100 accommodate between 100 accommodate between 60 and 80 students per class, while few others have between 60 and 80 students per class; which ende in the most than while liew others have between 60 and 80 students per class; which tends to be more than the required standard of be-tween 25 and 30 students per class, as recommended for

safety reopening.

The schools with large number of students per class, BusinessDey learnt, are to be given option of either running a shifting system or day inserval model of education, according to facilities at their disposals.

School principals in Lagos, who spoke with our correspondent on Wednesday, said they have already submitted their school needs and blue print regarding the reopening to state authorities, but wear quick to note that "most of the schools will operate either shifting system (unmining and afternoon session) or day instread system due to lack of adequate classrooms, health and communication facilities.

According to them, "Go-

According to them, "Going by the protocols require-ment for reopening, most of our public schools cannot meet with the required standand due to over population in classes and the only option left is either shifting or day interval

system.

"We have no option than to run either shifting or day interval system as to accommodate the large number of students in virtually 80 percent of public schools in the country, said Olamreveit Ontyltan, a principal of one of the public secondary schools in Lagos.

However, our correspondent gathered that public schools with fewer students would operate without shift since accommodation won't be an issue.

Abiola Seriki-Ayeni, the director-general, Office of Education Quality Assurance (OEQA), Lagos State speaking also with BusinessDey, said for the reopening to be successful, there are a few things required

to be put in place.
We need to have communications plan, health safety and academic plans in place to make sure that the behaviour of our students and staff are in alignment with the new nor-mal of Covid-19.



Two women and a child abducted over a month ago have finally regained their freedom from bandits who

their freedom from bandits who allegedly collected the sum of N300,000 as ransom. A close source to the released victims confirmed to Datly Trust that the husbands of the

beductees paid the said amount to the kidnappers before the victims were released.

Daily Trust had reported that two women were abducted, with one of them a nursing mother who was separated from the baby. Daily Trust gathered that the freed victims were receiving treatment at a hospital in libia town with the nursing mother in

bandits shot and abandoned him. The source added that the injured driver was discovered after two days by some villagers who went to the bush to collect firewood.

The driver disclosed that about 20 people were taken to the bush by the bandits.

When contacted, the Katsina Police spokesman, SP Gambo

Isah, confirmed the incident,

isah, confirmed the incident, saying, however that the number of people abducted was nine.

He said two victims were rescued, which include a woman who hid in the bush when she saw the bandlis, and the driver who was later discovered with severe injuries.

He said that investigation into the matter is ongoing.

Boy, 10, drowns in Kano

A 10-year-old boy, Aminu ilu, has drowned while taking a bath in a pond along Maiduguri road in Danladi Nasidi area of Kumbotso Local Government Area of Kano State. A statement issued yesterday by Alhaji Saidu Mohammed, the Public Relationa Officer of the state Fire Service, said the incident occurred yesterday morning. "We received a distress call from one. Ado Sule at about 09:57 a.m. On receiving the information, we quickly sent our rescue team to the scene at about

10:10 a.m. Ilu's corpse was handed over to the ward head of Mariri Kata village, Alhaji Gambo Adamu," he said.

He further said that the cause of the incident was being investigated.

This was coming barely two days after another boy got drowned in the state.

Paily Trust had reported that a 7-year-old boy. Umar Ado died in a well at Unguwa Uku by Yarabawa Street in Tarauni Local Government Area of the state.

The incident occurred on Tuesday evening when the deceased went to fetch water.

80 Niger civil servants dismissed over fraud
