





Jesus answered him, "It is also written: 'Do not put the Lord your God to the test ... Jesus said to him, "Away from me, Satan! For it is written: 'Worship the Lord your God, and serve him only. 

Prologue

The human soul is a perfectly spiritual entity, which originates from the purely spiritual regions of unblemished bliss, peace, eternal safety and absolute security. Therefore, the soul is a classical foreigner in this physical world. The anatomy, physiology and functional mechanisms of the soul are of such delicacy that it's entirely impossible for the soul to establish and maintain direct contact with this physical world, because this earthly realm is unbelievably coarse to the degree of its inability to sustain the delicacy and complex functional features of the soul. Consequently, to practically function in this physical world, the soul utilises tools that are adapted for operation in this physical world. These tools comprise the physical body, the astral body, the mind and the subconscious mind. It's rather pathetic that most souls who are reborn on earth usually nurture the goodwill to resolve their outstanding spiritual debt so that they can return to their native spiritual territory of infinite bliss and peace. Unfortunately, when souls are reborn on earth, they often forget their fundamental objective to resolve the entirety of their spiritual debt. Instead, they incur even more spiritual debt, aggravating their initial liability.

Eternal liberation of the soul is whereby the soul resolves the totality of its outstanding spiritual debt; and returns to its native land of infinite bliss and perfect safety.


Eternal liberation of the soul is by no means a mere belief or a wish, but a methodical process by which the soul progressively disentangles itself from the bondage of spiritual debt that ensnares it in this physical world; disposes of all its instruments of service, and flies back to its native land of everlasting bliss and freedom. Therefore, liberation of the soul is the highest human achievement ever. Every soul consciously or unconsciously yearns to resume its exalted native land. Thus, this section unveils the powerful means by which the soul can achieve eternal liberation from karma and reincarnation in this lifetime.



Dimensions of consciousness

The legendary Spiritual Masters usually maintain that the spiritual evolution of the human soul unfolds within the first five dimensions of consciousness in the physical universe. These five dimensions respectively comprise: the astral (emotional dimension), the mental (intellectual dimension), the third dimension, fourth dimension and fifth dimension of consciousness; illustrated thus as follows:




Below the planet earth are the deepest portions of hell, which serve as intensive care units for souls that are blemished by chronic moral and spiritual sickness. Just above the physical world is the astral dimension of consciousness. The physical world is connected to the astral world by a passage known as the transmigration tunnel. Souls which have passed on by way of death usually make their way to the astral world via the transmigration tunnel. The astral dimension is partitioned into seven sub-dimensions. The three sub-dimensions closest to the physical world serve as purgatories and hells; which are then connected by dark tunnels to the deepest portions of hell. The three upper sub-dimensions of the astral world are generally regarded as the first heaven. Sub-dimension four serves as a buffer zone between the three upper and the three lower sub-dimensions. Above the astral dimension is the mental or intellectual dimension.




The mental dimension is partitioned into seven sub-dimensions. The three upper sub-dimensions are the zones of abstract thought, while the three lower sub-dimensions are the zones of concrete thought. Sub-dimension four constitutes the depository of universal mind. During its downward journey, the soul picks up the mind from sub-dimension four; and during its upward journey of liberation, the soul discards the mind back to the depository of


universal mind in this sub-dimension. Also, in sub-dimension four can be found the akashic record or the akashic library; which is, the vast documentation system in the universe that contains the spiritual history of all the souls from when they were created till this material point in time.



The third, fourth and fifth dimensions of consciousness are territories of supreme bliss and endless happiness. The intensity of bliss and happiness proportionally increases from the third, fourth and fifth dimensions of consciousness respectively.




Hell or inferno serves as the garbage disposal bin of the universe; for, the coarsest and densest elements of material with which the universe was fashioned, has settled in hell. Also, hell serves as a temporary residence for beings who have violated the principles and laws that govern the universe. The deeper portions of hell are inhabited by zombie-like creatures and a host of other monstrous and horrifying beings. The three lowest sub-planes of the astral world serve as hellish abodes. These are connected by dark vertical tunnels to the most dreadful regions of hell, situated very deep beneath the surface of the earth.




How the Soul picks up its tools of service

When the soul resides in its native territories of spiritual liberty, it does not by any means require any tools of service. The native lands for the soul where it does not require externally derived tools of service comprise the third, fourth and fifth dimensions of consciousness. For the soul to function in the mental (intellectual), astral (emotional) and physical dimensions, it must employ externally derived tools, means by which it can survive and experience phenomena in those realms. For example, the human anatomy and physiology are not adapted to function in the sea. Therefore, if a diver is keen to experience life in the sea, he or she must necessarily put on a diving suite and an oxygen mask, in order to survive in the sea. Meanwhile the fish does not require an oxygen mask or a diving suite in order to survive in the sea, simply because the anatomy and physiology of the fish are adapted for survival in water.


Therefore, during the soul's journey from its native land to this physical world, it picks up tools for survival and experience, as it goes through the corresponding dimensions of consciousness. On the upper part of the mental dimension, the soul picks up the sub-conscious mind or the causal body; on the fourth sub-plane of the mental dimension, the soul picks up the mind from the depository of universal mind contained there; on the astral plane, the soul picks up the astral body and on the physical plane, the soul picks up the physical body. These scenarios are illustrated as follows:




Therefore, upon the soul's arrival on earth, the structural pattern of the soul's connection to its principal instruments of service is illustrated as follows:



Apart from its main instruments of service, the soul equally picks up a host of other smaller tools of service on each dimension of consciousness; such that by the time the soul arrives on earth, its structural connection to all the instruments of service it has picked up on its way to earth is as depicted below:



The above diagram illustrates how the soul is connected to its various instruments of service. It's imperative to indicate that while in the physical body, the soul itself takes up a place in the centre of the brain cavity, in that minute gland known as the pineal gland, thus illustrated as follows:



The logic of karma and reincarnation

So, as regards the tools for the soul, the sub-conscious mind serves as a depository or a storage chamber for all the experiences that the soul has had in the mental, astral and physical realms. The soul experiences mental energy with the conscious mind; it experiences emotional energy with the astral body and experiences physical phenomenon with the physical body, using its principal five senses and sensations of eyes for sight, mouth for taste, nose for smell, ears for hearing and the skin for the sensation of touch.


Therefore, to experience mental energy, the soul engages the mind; to experience emotional energy, the soul engages the astral body and to experience physical energy, the soul engages the physical body. Every single thought generated and exercised by the mind produces either positive or negative energy. A positive thought would generate positive energy, while a negative thought would generate negative energy. Also, every emotion generated and exercised by the astral body produces either positive or negative energy. Positive emotions generate positive energy, while negative emotions generate negative energy. Likewise every positive activity performed by the physical body generates either positive or negative energy. Positive actions generate positive energy while negative actions generate negative energy. The collection of all the energy generated by the mind, astral body and the physical body is what is referred to as karma or consequences. The totality of positive energy is referred to as positive karma; while the totality of negative energy is referred to as negative karma. Therefore, both positive and negative karma attach themselves to the soul through its instruments of service as a mass of energy. For the soul to return to its negative land, it must be entirely free of this mass of energy called karma. When the physical body dies when the energy attached to the soul has not yet been neutralised, the soul travels to the astral or mental dimension of consciousness with that mass of energy attached to it. While this mass of energy is still attached to the soul, it cannot possibly return to its native land because this mass of energy keeps on pulling the soul downwards, just like someone who would prefer to float on water, but a heavy stone tied to his or her waist compels the person to sink to the depth of the sea. So, after death, the soul spends a certain amount of time in the astral or mental dimensions of consciousness, and after that, this mass of energy attached to the soul pulls back the soul to earth, where the energy was created.

Therefore, the return of the soul on earth to be born in another physical body is known as reincarnation. For a detailed and almost exhaustive discussion about karma and reincarnation, refer to the book titled: *The Law of Karma and Reincarnation: How it Operates and Affects your life*, by Emmanuel Ebah.

The danger zones of the universe

The danger zones of the universe are those dimensions of consciousness where the law of karma and reincarnation operates. The law of karma and reincarnation operates from the mental (intellectual) dimension, through the astral world, physical world, right down to hell. Therefore, all the dimensions of consciousness situated where the law of karma and reincarnation operates are considered gravely unsafe for the prolonged stay of souls in those realms. In these territories, nothing is guaranteed as a matter of course. In one lifetime, you may bask in the most admirable form of glory, but in the next reincarnation, you may be born in circumstances in which you just manage survival on bread crumbs, if your record of karma changed for the worse. On the other hand, you may dwell in absolute misery in this lifetime, but reincarnate in circumstances of absolute and enviable fortune. Again, this would be determined by your karma. In brief, it's the record of your karma that dictates the circumstances into which you are born. In this lifetime, you may be born into one race and in the next reincarnation, you might take birth in an entirely different race. For instance, in this lifetime, if you hated a particular race and exhibited a chronic form of racism towards that race, in your next reincarnation, you may take birth in the race that you very much despised in your previous life.

Therefore, the mental, astral, physical and hellish dimensions of consciousness are deemed very unsafe for the soul. In this regard, the most unsafe zone is hell, followed by this physical world, then the astral region; and finally the mental dimension of consciousness.



The safe and eternally joyful zones of the universe

The purely spiritual regions; comprising the third, fourth and fifth dimension of consciousness are generally considered the safe zones for the soul. In these zones, the law of karma and reincarnation is entirely non-existent; and the soul abides in eternal glory, bliss and peace. Hence, the law of karma and reincarnation only operates in the dimensions where the soul employs tools of service such as the mind, astral body and the physical body. In the purely spiritual regions however, the soul is abiding in its native land and thus has no use for these tools of service.

The meaning of Eternal Liberation of the Soul

Liberation of the soul is a scenario whereby the soul successfully resolves the totality of the mental, emotional, verbal and physical karma that it has accumulated during successive reincarnations on earth; disposes of all the tools of service that it employs to experience the lower dimensions of consciousness; soars above the dangerous zones that are characterised by karma and reincarnation; and finally returns to its native land of pure spiritual phenomenon; where it enjoys eternal bliss and peace.

During the process of the soul's arrival on earth, it picks up tools of service as it traverses the various dimensions of consciousness en route to the planet earth. During the process of liberation however, the soul progressively disposes of all the tools it picked up during its downward journey. In this scenario, as the soul ascends towards its native land, it disposes of each tool of service in the same dimension of consciousness where it was picked up during the soul's downward journey. Thus, in the physical world, the soul disposes of the physical body and proceeds to the astral dimension. There, it disposes of the astral body and proceeds to the mental or intellectual dimension. There, it disposes of the conscious mind and the causal body or sub-consciousness mind; and then proceeds to its native spiritual land in its bare state of purity. Therefore, liberation of the soul is illustrated as follows:

Why eternal liberation of the soul is essential for all of us

For it is not in so far as he is man that he will live so, but in so far as something divine is present in him; and by so much as this is superior to our composite nature is its activity superior to that which is the exercise of the other kind of virtue. If reason is divine, then, in comparison with man, the life according to it is divine in comparison with human life. But we must not follow those who advise us, being men, to think of human things, and, being mortal, of mortal things, but must, so far as we can, make ourselves immortal, and strain every nerve to live in accordance with the best thing in us; for even if it be small in bulk, much more does it in power and worth surpass everything. This would seem, too, to be each man himself, since it is the authoritative and better part of him. It would be strange, then, if he were to choose not the life of his self but that of something else.

(Aristotle, Nicomachaean Ethics, X:7)

In congruence with Aristotle's above delineated enunciation, an individual who has attained the arena of no compromise in seeking the ultimate truth about himself, of God and of the universe, has chosen not the life of something else, but that of himself.

Matters pertaining to top spiritual secrets had historically been almost entirely restricted to the sacred and mysterious chambers of a handful of ascetics. Verbal promiscuity of heavenly and spiritual secrets was prohibited; and knowledge of ultimate spiritual realities remained the deserved prerogative of a minute proportion of accomplished ascetics. The luxury of explicit and undisguised spiritual knowledge was debarred from the public domain; and confined to the rigorous custody of a privileged few; who have measured up to the standard of unsurpassed austerity.

Nonetheless, in this contemporary era, there has been a sudden alteration of policy as regards rigidity in disclosing profound spiritual realities to the multitudes. Spiritual knowledge and heavenly truths have now been discharged onto the public arena to a substantially unprecedented scale, as opposed to yesteryears. Nowadays, any one who displays a considerable degree of assiduity in questing spiritual treasures will be met with the facility for appeasing his or her yearning without excessive labour and exorbitant tribulations as historically was the case.

So, what must have orchestrated such an abrupt alteration of policy, from relative stinginess in spiritual disclosures to this era of impressive endowment in spiritual disclosures? The answer is that mankind is in the verge of selfextermination. The evil forces that mankind had being orchestrating and incubating on this planet over the years have amassed to a critical degree as to unleash their cumulative lethality to the extent that would subject mankind to the most despicable calamities ever witnessed. In view of those potential and impending calamities that now corner mankind and which have the despicable tendency for yielding the most horrendous ordeals upon the very mankind which itself engendered and perpetuated the antecedents of such potential calamities, the policy designers in the heavenly dimensions have devised an emergency strategy; whose keen observance can enable mankind to evade, neutralise or minimise looming calamities that it has manufactured by its blatant abidance to unproductive demeanour. Part of that strategy is the hastened dissemination of authentic spiritual knowledge and the putting in place of a means for spiritual cultivation, by which positive energy can be generated, which alone can dilute the intensity of malicious forces that now envelope and pervade most of humanity. Moreover, most of the humans that now inhabit this planet originate from the higher spiritual dimensions of consciousness; and the duration of their stay onto this befuddling physical abode is long overdue. The Supreme lord is seriously worried about their welfare and hence, they must be presented with a means by which they can return to their glorious abodes. They must derive retirement from their lacerating adventures on this tiresome territory called earth. The time is now due for the prodigal son to embrace the royal highway to the father's palace. He can no longer persist in abstaining from his status as his father's progeny, and in so doing, calling upon himself the most despicable agony.

So, what are the antecedent factors that prompt one to assume the honourable position of a fervent spiritual aspirant?

Such an individual might have been paralysed by horror or even dumbfounded upon observance of multiple instances where mother nature has unleashed her enragement upon humanity; as for instance, despicable episodes of unpreventable seismic calamities and other natural disasters such as prolonged drought and famine, abominable climatic extremities , destructive torrential downpours with attendant repercussions, mortal instances of technological failures with devastating consequences such as plane crashes and other technology-related fatalities. He is deeply saddened and almost emotionally paralysed by the despicable and perpetual episodes of inter-human slaughter by way of both international and national scenarios of fierce belligerency.

He strenuously contemplates that behavioural psychology labels man as an intelligent agent, endowed with rational and deliberative faculties; and ponders why the rational agency of this so called rational agent exhibits such conspicuous animalistic instincts as expressly manifest in vivid inter-human barbarism. He recounts and envisions countless situations where people are mercilessly griped by chronic impoverishment, wretchedness, starvation and desperation to the point of sheer bewilderment. He recaptures that even nations spared these agents of misery and who are endowed with relative abundance are also plagued by a different category of affliction; for instance, restlessness and enslavement to the means for survival and the preservation of perceived security. He is severely anguished by the pluralistic prevalence of perilous maladies that torment many a multitude, for instance, Aids, cancer, cardiovascular ailments, kidney and liver dysfunctions, insanity, depression, disability of numerous facets such as blindness, deafness etc. He is deeply traumatised by the sudden death of a love one or to the unpredicted and unexpected occurrence of some heart-aching hazardous incident to someone within his personal orbit.

He has witnessed someone transcend onto mundane fame overnight; and he has equally witnessed some other person collapse from fame overnight. He therefore reflects that irrespective of his own relatively satisfactory and secured position, it would be grossly deceptive and indeed imprudent to assign any sentiments of guarantee to his current condition. It becomes vividly clear to him that no one is immune to misfortune; and by virtue of that domineering vulnerability; even present perceived security is indeed insecure. He had witnessed abysmal instances of segregation on grounds of body pigmentation. He observes that inter-ethnic and inter-religious repulsion are rife; while alienation on grounds of gender and social orientation has become a socio-cultural emblem. He realises that disease, old age and death are mandatory, even though dreaded visitors of every self-preserving person. He is also astonished that even his own physical body, emotions and mind have in numerous occasions demonstrated their insufficiency of loyalty to him. He therefore concludes that physical life is characterised by unreliability; it is uncertain, unpredictable, perilous, nefarious, delusive and thus trust worthless. By every existing device, it has woefully failed to fulfil the criteria of a

trustworthy medium from which enduring happiness and guaranteed welfare can be secured. Disgruntled by the caprice, fictitiousness and worthlessness of mundane life, he mobilises his devices and enquires as to whether a more dependable and trustworthy version of existence prevails; and how such can be reached if it does exist. He is accorded the electrifying and assuring briefing that spiritual cultivation and spiritual life constitutes the ultimate abode of human utopianism. Such a discovery reinforces his own initial sentiments and propensity. He therefore affirms such a disclosure with preliminary jubilancy and cordial exhilaration. He motions onto its peripheral horizons to commence exploring its treasures and certainties. He is tenaciously and entirely geared towards reaching a means by which he can secure permanent and not short-term immunity from misfortune; but he also aspires to establish the underlining causes of all human miseries and the nature of such causes themselves.

He commences his critical investigation by preliminarily conducting visitations to every library of reputation that he can access. He examines the content of each and every philosophical book with full-scale keenness. He assimilates the philosophical thoughts of Socrates, Plato, Aristotle, Spinoza, Confucius, Lao Tze, just to mention a few. He executes a meticulous examination of the scriptures of all the major religions in the world, for instance, he exhausts the Christian bible, he critically examines the Buddhist Sutras with unreserved keenness. He commences to scrutinise the range of available metaphysical postulations that had existed from time immemorial. He detects parallels and paradoxes amongst the various spiritual conceptions. He derives significant cognitive edification from the diverse spiritual concepts examined so far, but he is also somewhat bewildered by the apparent absurdities that resonate in some of these concepts. Without seeking and obtaining retrenchment from his mere intellectual investigation, he comes to the awareness that his spiritual quest is real but the material examined thus far is simply conceptual in character, devoid of any practical and realistic feasibility for appeasing his spiritual starvation. He acutely realises that these elaborate metaphysical concepts, various philosophical tenets and religious scriptures are simply posing as a spiritual á la carte menu; but appreciates that no menu can ever deliver food into a hungry person's stomach.

He fully captures the fact that a menu is at best a literally inscription of available delicacies; and an indication of their respective flavours. He maintains

the vigorous awareness that his soul is desperate for spiritual nectar. Eternal liberation of the soul can be pursued and achieved by anyone who is prepared to exert the required effort to that effect. Nonetheless, eternal liberation of the soul is by no means a haphazard phenomenon, but a prodigious undertaking that requires a definite scientific method. Hence, for one to pursue and achieve liberation of the soul in this lifetime, three requirements must be fulfilled as follows: the method, the right effort and the guidance.

Both the method and the guidance are offered by a high order Spiritual Master; while the individual is expected to consistently exert the right effort. All scientists are fully aware that to achieve the desired results in any scientific experiment, the investigator must observe a particular scientific method or a set of standard procedures. If the investigator scrupulously and consistently observes the required method, then the expected results must be achieved. Also, no medical student can successfully become a qualified medical doctor, without the supervision of a competent expert, who is well versed in medicine. Also, for anyone to achieve liberation of the soul in this lifetime, the soulliberating method and the supervision must be offered to the individual by someone who has already achieved a high level of competence in the domain of liberation of the soul. Such an unsurpassed high profile expert in matters of the human soul is the high order Spiritual Master. Therefore, liberation of the soul can be stated as follows:

Right method + Right guidance + Right effort = **Eternal Liberation of the soul**

The Role of Meditation in the Eternal Liberation of the Soul

The connection between the soul and its tools of service is generally designed to be provisional, rather than permanent. For instance, when a diver puts on a diving suit and an oxygen mask, this is intended to enable the diver survive in the environment of the sea, where the normal physical features cannot survive by their own independent devices. Under normal circumstances, the diving suit and oxygen mask should be discarded, once the diver concludes his or her mission in water. So also, the soul employs its tools of service to experience life in their respective zones of functionality. Once the respective experiences are fully assimilated by the soul, it's normally supposed to discard these tools of service; and return to its native land of eternal spiritual freedom. Nonetheless, during the soul's supposed temporary association with its tools of service, these tools more often generate an intense degree of negative energy, which hardens their attachment to the soul; and renders it extremely difficult, if not impossible for the soul to dissociate itself from these tools, for an eventual return to its native territory of absolute spiritual bliss. Therefore, meditation is a process whereby the soul harnesses the supreme divine energy contained within itself, which enables it to dissolve the intense energy generated by its respective tools. Once the soul dissolves this energy generated by its tools that hardens their connection to the soul, these tools then unfasten themselves from the soul, one after the other, permitting the soul to soar to its native land of inconceivable spiritual bliss. Thus, meditation enables the individual to break the very solid bond, which prevails between the soul and its tools of service. For instance, when water is heated at a temperature of 100 °C, the hydrogen bonds that connect the oxygen and hydrogen atoms are broken, enabling the oxygen and hydrogen atoms to separate during the process of evaporation. In the same manner, the supreme energy generated by meditation dissolves the bond between the soul and its tools of service; permitting the soul to withdraw from them; and to return to its native land of eternal spiritual freedom. Consequently, meditation is an absolute necessity for anyone who seeks to achieve eternal liberation of the soul.

Why the Quan Yin Method of Meditation is the best for your soul

Two very prominent and distinctive qualities of the spiritual dimensions or the heavens is that they are characterised by the constant presence of glorious and blissful **divine light** and **divine sound vibrations** or **sound currents**. Just as the physical world is characterised by **land**, **water** (sea, rivers, streams, lakes etc) and the **atmosphere**, so also are the spiritual dimensions characterised by light and sound. This sound is also referred to as sound vibrations, sound current, divine melody etc. Therefore, the physical world is composed of the three states of matter, comprising solid, liquid and gas. Even the physical body is composed of solid, liquid and gas, to reflect the principal three states of matter prevalent on earth. As a matter of fact, even the physical body is also nourished with these three states of matter, because the body can only be sustained with the substance with which it is composed; for instance, when you consume rice, that represents solid; when you drink water, that represents liquid; and when you inhale oxygen into the lungs, that represents gas.

So, since the human soul is a product of the spiritual worlds, it is therefore composed of the same material as the atmosphere of those spiritual worlds, just as the physical body is composed of the three states of matter representing the qualities of the earth. Thus, the human soul is composed of divine light and divine sound as the spiritual dimensions or the heavens. Since an entity can only be nourished with that with which it is composed, it follows that the soul can only be nourished with divine light and divine sound. Consequently, meditation is the process by which the soul harnesses and nourishes itself with the divine light and divine sound contained in itself. Meditation is also the process by which the soul equally withdraws even more of that divine light and divine sound directly from the spiritual dimensions .Divine sound currents emerge from the highest spiritual dimension and flow downwards, right down to the lowest dimension, which indeed is the planet earth.
